PAINT STRIPPING USING ORANGE-PEEL

THE FRIENDLY WAY TO REMOVE PAINT

Marine grade ORANGE-PEEL paint and varnish gel can remove multi layers of product in one application, and when covered it will keep working for 24 hours. With its great citrus smell, it is ideal for interior or exterior use. Its gel formula allows it to work on vertical surfaces.

WHAT IS ORANGE-PEEL?

ORANGE-PEEL is a paint and varnish stripping gel that effectively removes coatings from wood, metal, masonry and gelcoat. Its unique formula is safer, and strips most acrylics, anti-foulings, polyurethanes, epoxies and varnishes.

ORANGE-PEEL is thick so it sticks to vertical surfaces, and the bright orange colour makes it stand out, so you can easily see where it has been applied.

DOES ORANGE-PEEL HAVE DANGEROUS FUMES?

Most paint strippers contain chemicals that can give off harsh fumes, requiring you to work outdoors. ORANGE-PEEL'S safer NON Methylene Chloride formula and pleasant orange scent makes is suitable for indoor or outdoor use.

EASY TO USE.

When using ORANGE-PEEL test a small area first for compatibility, as it may affect some plastics, rubbers, and gelcoats.

ORANGE-PEEL will not evaporate. Once covered with glad wrap or plastic sheeting it will stay wet up to 24 hours - while paint strippers are wet, they are still working. This will allow you to strip an entire surface in one application.

When stripping coatings from gelcoats, apply ORANGE-PEEL to small areas at a time and check every 15 minutes. Once the paint is soft, remove all traces of ORANGE-PEEL using a sugar soap solution, rinse with fresh water.

Stripping a large area like a timber deck can be done easily. Wet the area to keep it cool. Apply ORANGE-PEEL liberally, then cover with a plastic drop sheet, holding this in place with bricks. Leave overnight. In the morning remove the cover, the coating will stick to the plastic, so dispose of the cover sheet after use. Use a power washer to clean off the residual ORANGE-PEEL and paint. ORANGE-PEEL is water based, so will not affect plants or grass when diluted with water, such as in a cleaning process.

Orange Peel will leave your timber looking natural, unlike Methylene Chloride base strippers which can burn and stain timber.
