DESCRIPTION:	A single pack, low-odour Satin finish enamel with excellent weathering characteristics in
	salt laden environments.

USES: Can be used on most surfaces including timber, steel, aluminium and concrete, as long as they are primed and properly prepared.

PREPARATION:	 New Timber – Prime with Norseal (if required) and NORGLASS PRi-COAT. Follow with a further 1-2 coats, allowing 24 hours (minimum) drying between coats. Finish with 2 coats of Weatherfast Satin White. OTHER SUBSTRATES: Refer to appropriate NORGLASS product Information sheets. Previously painted surfaces – require cleaning down with NORCLEAN-PLUS, removal of flaking or unsound paint and sanding with 220-360 grit sandpaper to remove any existing gloss.
APPLICATION:	Stir contents before use. Apply by brush, short nap roller or by spray. In hot weather a maximum of 5% Weatherfast Brushing Thinner may be added to assist brushing. For conventional spray equipment, thin up to 33 1/3% at 50-60 PSI with Norglass Weatherfast Spraying Thinners. For other spray equipment use less spraying thinners according to the unit recommendations.
TRANSPORTATION:	DG Class 3 HAZCHEM 3Y P.G. III Sizes available: 4 litre, 2litre, 1 litre, 500ml and 250ml.
PRECAUTIONS:	Provide adequate ventilation during use. Do Not Smoke. Flammable liquid – keep away from flames, excessive heat and sparks. Wear correct apparatus when applying by spray. Do not use on areas of constant immersion.
FIRST AID:	If poisoning occurs call a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Aust) on 13 11 26 or (NZ) 0800 764 766 and have label information ready. If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting.
