DESCRIPTION:	A heat resistant, self priming paint to be used in areas that are subjected to heat.

- PREPARATION:** The area must be thoroughly clean of all surface contaminants like oil, rust scale or grease and dirt. Just prior to painting the surface should be wiped down with NORGLASS NORCLEAN-PLUS to remove any remaining contamination.
- APPLICATION:** Stir thoroughly. Apply two coats, with a light sand between coats using 240 grit sandpaper. Wipe down with Norclean again before applying second coat. Can be applied by brush, roller or spray.
- TRANSPORTATION:** Class 3 HAZCHEM 3Y P.G III
- PRECAUTIONS:** **The coating must be cured for a minimum of 1 week before exposed to heat. Not suitable for BBQ hot plates or oven interiors.**
- FIRST AID:** If poisoning occurs call a doctor or Poisons Information Centre (Aust) on 1311 26 or (NZ) 0800 764 766 and have label information ready.
If swallowed DO NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water.
